



## AXS-One Company Timeline

### 1978

- Computron is founded, offering easily customizable financial software, other custom ERP and office automation solutions for major businesses

### 1981

- Delivers first-of-its-kind parameter-driven packaged financial solutions with interoperability for interfacing with any third-party products

### 1987

- Leads the industry with new 3-tier software architecture – isolating presentation, processing and database access – allowing for open systems development
- One of the first to release software responding to Y2k issues

### 1989

- Introduces stand-alone, parameter-driven workflow software solutions with integrated imaging
- Releases first set of products for the open-systems market

### 1991

- First to integrate workflow with financial applications to streamline business processes for major financial transaction systems – proprietary as well as non-proprietary
- Introduces Client Server products with first-generation thin client/fat server model GUI (Graphical User Interface)

### 1993

- Releases second-generation thin client/fat server GUI (Graphical User Interface) across Windows, Unix and Apple desktop platforms

### 1994

- Introduces COLD product – COOL (Computer Output Online) – wins “Best of AIIM” industry award for high-volume report archiving, viewing and manipulation

### 1995

- Computron goes public
- COOL (Computer Output Online) integrated with workflow

### 1996

- Introduces first-generation HTML lite browser-based Internet access to applications
- Expands to 32-bit thin client technology using Visual Basic as the forms editor

### 1998

- COOLNet wins “Best of AIIM” for Java application
- Introduces precursor to AXS-Desk, as well as Internet-ready applications
- Announces new R&D focus on the “virtual corporation” and e-business solutions
- Financial software becomes EURO compliant

## 1999

- Demonstrates new e-business solutions for procurement and vendor self-service
- Launches AXSPoint technology division for OEMs, VARS and Resellers
- Launches Tivity division for professional services organizations (PSOs)

## 2000

- Changes name to AXS-One to reflect its new emphasis on e-business solutions

## 2001

- Introduces AXS-One Enterprise, a suite of process-centric e-business solutions
- Incorporates new generation of XML-based tools interoperable with other systems

## 2002

- Introduces Web Services for Financial Value Chain Integration & Process Automation
- Wins AIIM's Best Practices: Enterprise Content Management Award
- Recognized by Transform Magazine for "Best of AIIM: Web Services"
- Expands Compliance Management Solution to include e-mail and instant messaging
- First Web Services system goes live

## 2003

- Announces general availability of Compliance Platform
- Named a Leading Visionary in the Gartner IDARS (Integrated Document Archive and Retrieval Systems) Quadrant
- Named a Visionary in the Gartner E-mail Active Archive Quadrant

- Receives SAP Certification for its Enterprise Content Management Solution
- AXSPoint Electronic Delivery Service becomes industry standard for electronic delivery, presentment and -dispute resolution for Tour Operators in the United Kingdom and Europe
